Presentation

The programme provides students with an advanced training in the field of Architectural Design and develops theoretical, humanistic, artistic and design competences based on the Italian tradition, facing different housing cultures, the new forms and spaces of contemporary cities, the development of new urban settlements in developing countries, the innovation in building techniques and environmental sustainability.

The educational path is focused on Studios dealing with architectural projects at different levels, from single buildings to urban and landscape projects. The main objective is to acquire thorough understanding of the complex relationships between the work of architecture and the city concerned, also focusing on heritage and preservation, on sustainability and environmental compatibility both in European and in developing countries. To enrich the educational training and career opportunities, in addition to curricular activities, the School also offers several international Open Lectures, Seminars and Workshops. The programme is taught in **English**.

Eligible students

Students holding a BSc degree in Architecture are eligible for application. The candidate is required to provide a portfolio and an English language certificate.

Subjects

The following is a sample of a typical study plan:

First year:

Architectural Design Studio, Urban Design Studio, Architectural Preservation Studio, Construction and Sustainability Design Studio, Contemporary Architectural Design Theory, History of Contemporary Architecture, Structural Design, Advanced Computational Design

Second year:

Thematic Design Studio, Final Design Studio, Elective and Thematic Courses, Internship, MSc Thesis

Fees

For **EU students** fees are based on students' family income and on the presented study plan. They range from about €900 to €3,900 per year.

For **Non-EU students** fees amount to about €3,900 per year.
